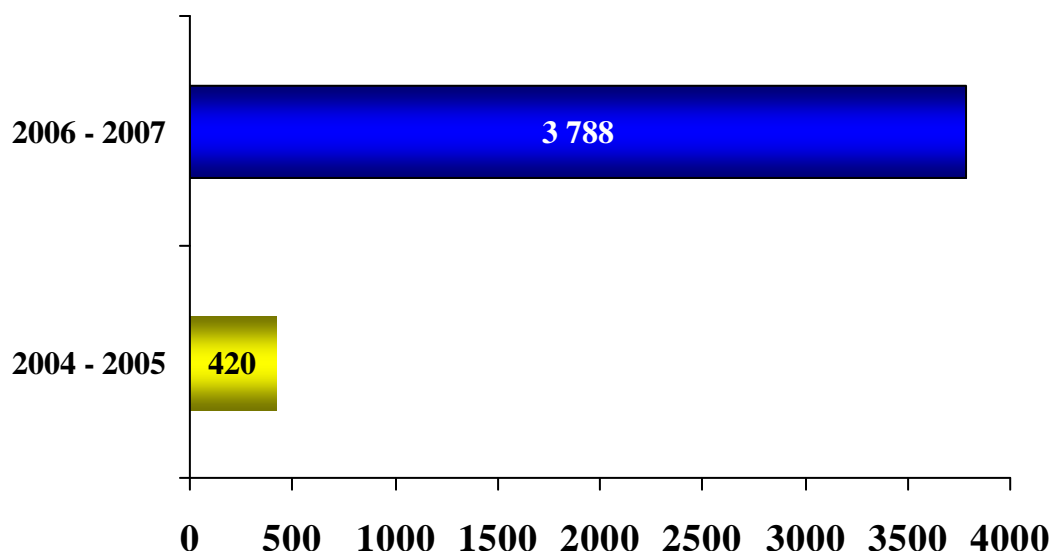


ANTI-CORRUPTION TRAININGS 2007

In 2007 3,251 civil servants in the central, regional and local administration have been trained in courses and seminars on prevention and countering corruption carried out by the Institute on Public Administration and European Integration (IPAEI) as follows:

- **335** under the specialized training program for **managers and officials in the inspectorates and the Chief Inspectorate** on “The Role of the Inspectorates in Prevention and Countering Corruption in the Public Administration”.
- **1,862** under the module program of the **National Plan for Prevention and Countering Corruption** (5 topics, adapted for each target group) for conducting a specialized training of different groups of officials from the central and local public administration.
- **809** under the module training program for **internet-based distance training on anticorruption** for all levels of the public administration working in the conditions of enhanced corruption risk.
- **245** under the IPAEI Catalogue

**Anti-corruption trainings for the period
2004-2005 and 2006-2007**



In 2006-2007, a total of 3,788 officials in the central and local administration were trained in courses and seminars on prevention and countering corruption carried out by the Institute on Public Administration and European Administration (IPAEA). This exceeds by **more than nine times** the trainings held in the period 2004-2005.

As from 2008 each department is obliged to plan funds for mandatory training under the IPAEI annual training program on ethics and anti-corruption for all new civil servants and newly appointed managers.
