

**Checks conducted by the Inspectorates within the central administration  
for the period October 2006 – March 2007**

For the period October 2006 – March 2007 the Inspectorates under Art. 46 and 46a of the Law on Administration have conducted a total of 954 inspections, of which 328 planned and 636 ad hoc checks. The Customs Agency has conducted the largest number of ad hoc checks – 215. The Agency for Social Assistance has conducted a total 288 checks of which 151 planned and 137 ad hoc checks which is approximately 50 % of the checks performed.
